What Is a Chaplain?



The word "chaplain" comes from an ancient story about love in action. In 337 A.D., a Roman officer named Martin encountered a beggar shivering in the cold at the entrance of Amiens, France. While others ignored the man, Martin cut his military cape in two and gave half to him. This act of compassion marked his life forever, and Martin decided to dedicate his life to serving the poor and needy.

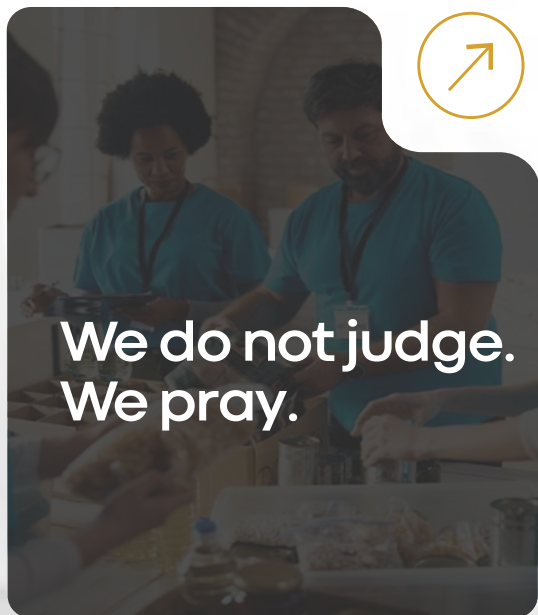
The cape Martin shared was later kept as a spiritual relic in a building called a chapel, and the person in charge of caring for it was called a chaplain.

The Mission of the Chaplain at Amazing Grace Outreach

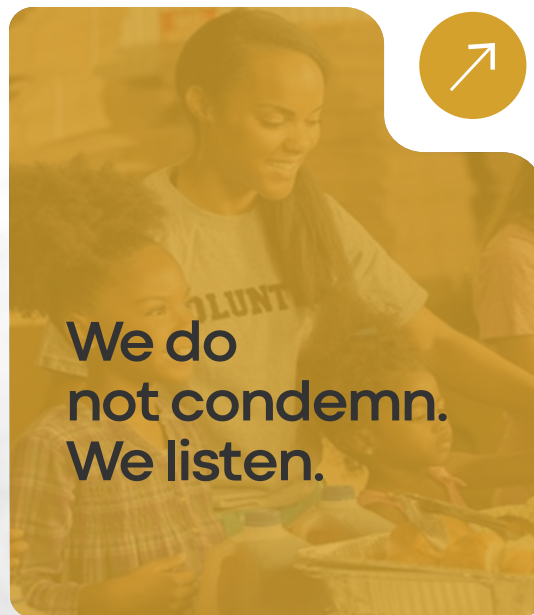

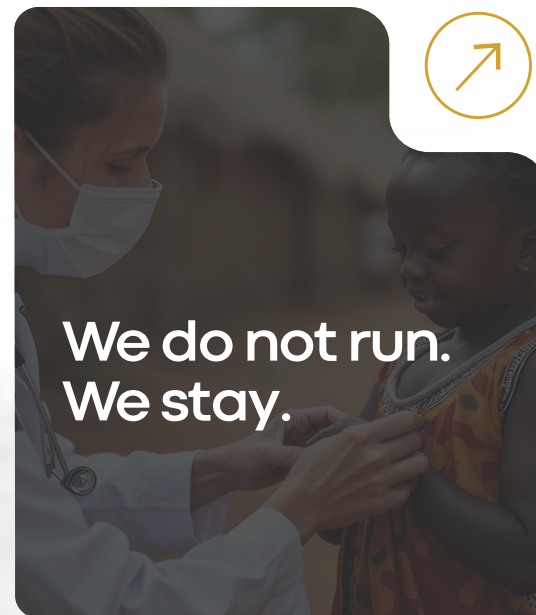

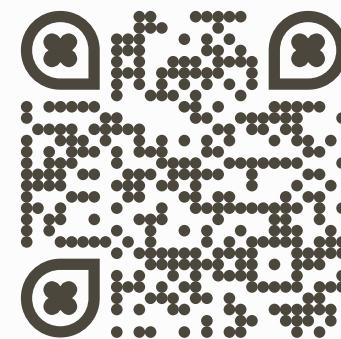
